

Protect Your Investment: Recognize LMR[®] Cable Clones



LMR[®] coaxial cable was the first flexible, low-loss, 50 Ohm cable option designed for low-loss signal transmission, high-flexibility, and high durability in a lightweight design. Since then, many fakes and clones have appeared in the coaxial cable market.

Learn More About the Pitfalls of Fake Cables

LMR[®] is a registered trademark of Times Microwave Systems. It is not a generic cable term other companies are free to use.

One of the strengths of the LMR[®] product line is it offers a complete package from the cable to the connectors to the tools for termination and installation. An RF interconnect is only as strong as its weakest point, the transition from cable to connector, so the tools for creating that cable-connector transition are crucial.

How to Spot the Fake and Clone Cables

What to Look For

Fakes are counterfeit products, typically not produced in the United States, that market themselves as being a brand name cable but are not. **Clones** don't necessarily claim to be the name brand product but are copies of the genuine product without the technical expertise behind it.



To verify you're getting a genuine LMR[®] cable, look for:

- Times Microwave Systems name
- Manufacturing Location
- Registered trademark after LMR[®]

LMR[®] cable from Times Microwave Systems will have our logo printed on the reel.



What to Watch Out For

Common phrasing includes:

- Alternative to LMR
- LMR Alternative
- Equivalent to LMR
- Similar Cables



Deceptive Labeling

Some may label their cables as LMR[®] even though they are not genuine LMR[®] cables, as true LMR[®] is only manufactured by us.

Name Brand vs. Store Brand

Some may claim that the only difference is Name Brand vs. Store Brand, but this is incorrect, as genuine LMR[®] cables are trademarked by us.





Unlabeled Reel

A reel of genuine LMR[®] from Times Microwave Systems will typically have our branding visible on the reel itself. An unlabeled reel or reel with different branding is not genuine LMR[®].
